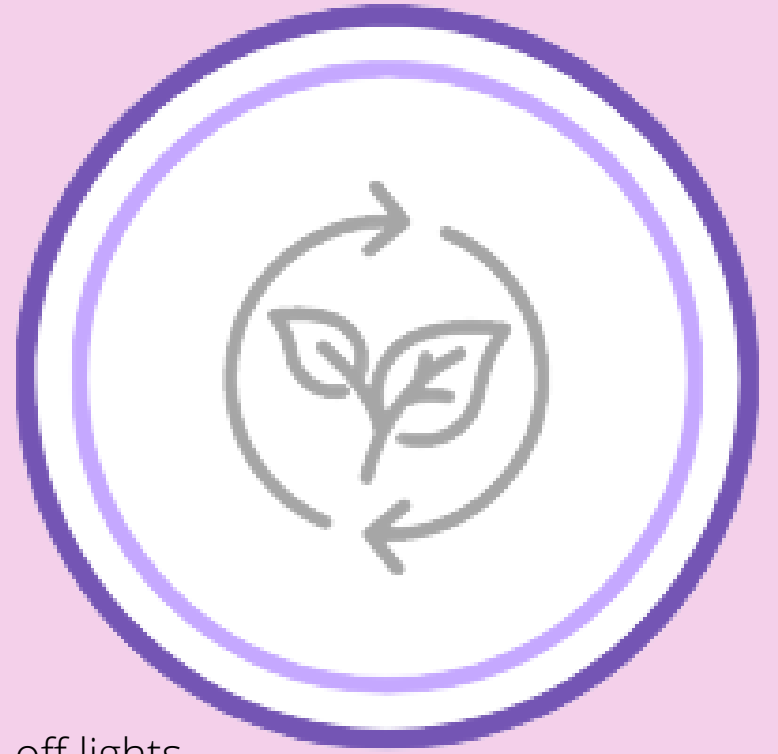
ENVIRONMENTAL

Responsible use and management of natural resources to ensure that they are available for future generations.

You can encourage environmental sustainability by teaching children about the importance of;

You can help children to understand the impact of their actions on the environment by showing them how to sort recyclable materials, explaining the benefits of composting, and encouraging them to turn off lights and appliances when not in use



SOCIAL
